2 Sections (age as of December 31, 2021): Senior Championship (50 & older only), Adult U1800 (ages 18 and up; under 18 allowed if accompanied by a playing adult). An open section for ages 18-49 will be added if 6 or more commit in advance, contact the organizer if interested.

Format: 5 round Swiss, G/75, d10. One ½-point by erounds 1-4, commit by end of round 2. Sets provided, *please bring clocks!* Optional Friday evening blitz for all ages, see details below.

Prizes: Trophies to top players in each section. *Ohio Senior Champion* title & trophy to top-finishing Ohio resident in Senior section. First time players (in this event), and returning players who recruit first time players, will be entered in drawings for a gift certificate good towards on-site lodging, gift shop or restaurant purchases.

Entry Fee: \$45 for entries paid <u>online</u> or received by 9/20, \$55 thereafter. <u>Enter online</u> (check or credit card) or mail entry with check payable to Fellowship of the King Chess Club, c/o Grant Neilley, 13270 Saylor Rd, Baltimore, OH 43105. No checks for on site entries. Refund less \$7 admin fee if withdraw by noon 9/24, then 50% until end of registration.

Schedule: Registration Sat 9:15-10:00am, rounds 10:15-2:00-6:30; Sunday 9:30-1:15. Optional Friday evening rated blitz open to all ages, G5 d/2, register on site by 7:45pm, round 1 8pm. Entry fee \$10, 60-70% paid out as prizes. Pairings & rounds at TD discretion.

Golden Buckeye COVID Update

Please be aware we may be in very close quarters with the number of players expected. Boards will **not** be socially distanced.

Unless a new state, local or facility mandate is put in place, we will **not** require masks. We do *encourage* you wear a mask, especially if you are not vaccinated.

We will **not** do temperature checks. We will **not** require proof of vaccination or a negative COVID test.

Hand sanitizer will be available or bring your own. We are not planning to sanitize sets between each round, but wipes will be available if you wish to use them.

We will require everyone to sign a health liability waiver and verify they are not currently experiencing any COVID or other illness symptoms, and have not been in contact with anyone else with COVID in the prior 10 days.

Especially given the current prevalence of COVID and the Delta variant, before you come to the event you should carefully weigh any other health conditions you already have, your comfort level with the precautions we are and are not taking, and the potential risk of spreading or contracting COVID by participating. As much as I'm looking forward to seeing every one of you there, I want to *continue* seeing you there for a long time to come! If in doubt, consider taking a pass this year.

Though this should go without saying, do NOT come to the tournament if you are ill, COVID or otherwise. As a reminder, the most common symptoms of COVID, which may range from very mild to severe, can include:

- Fever or chills
- Cough
- Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- Fatigue
- Muscle or body aches
- Headache
- New loss of taste or smell
- Sore throat
- Congestion or runny nose
- Nausea or vomiting
- Diarrhea
